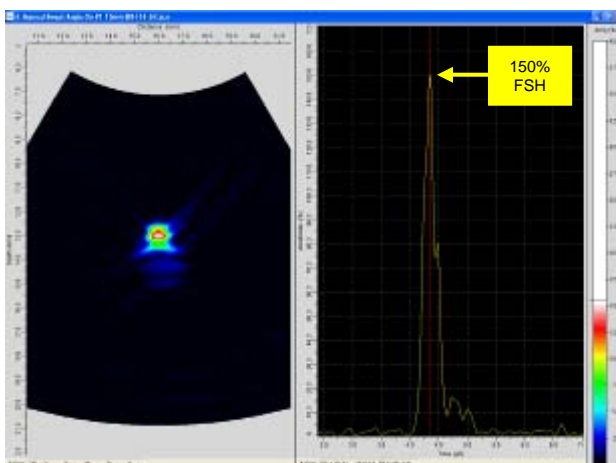
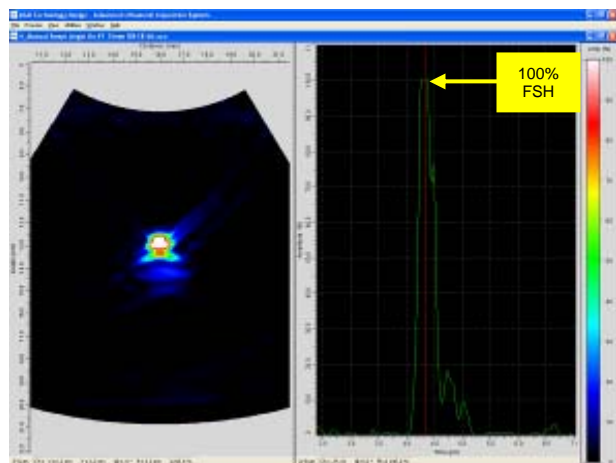

TIP OF THE MONTH



Did you know that you can improve the dynamic amplitude range on the TD Focus-Scan, TD-Scan & TD Handy-Scan instruments by using 14-bit digitization? A 14-bit sample rate increases the amplitude range from 100% to 400% FSH. This means that there is much less chance of important signals saturating, thereby improving the ability to size defects using amplitude drop methods. 14-bit sampling also improves the ability to analyse very low amplitude signals by improving the data resolution. Find the **Bits per Sample** control at **Setup-Channel-Hardware-Digitiser Control**

TEMPORARY LICENCE CODES

In response to customer feedback all TD Scan, Focus-Scan and Handy-Scan systems are now supplied with a temporary licence code for 30 days - allowing the system to be used direct from the box without having to make a call to get the system licensed. Unfortunately due to the way the TD Pocket Scan stores a temporary code, once the software is successfully installed onto your PC then you must still call for a code to be given. All codes remain temporary only until the system is finally purchased upon when a full final code will be given when you call up for renewal.

We are able to issue codes during normal office hours or where possible via the switchboard out of hours emergency service. If you have any queries relating to the licensing issue please discuss them with your sales representative or any member of our team.

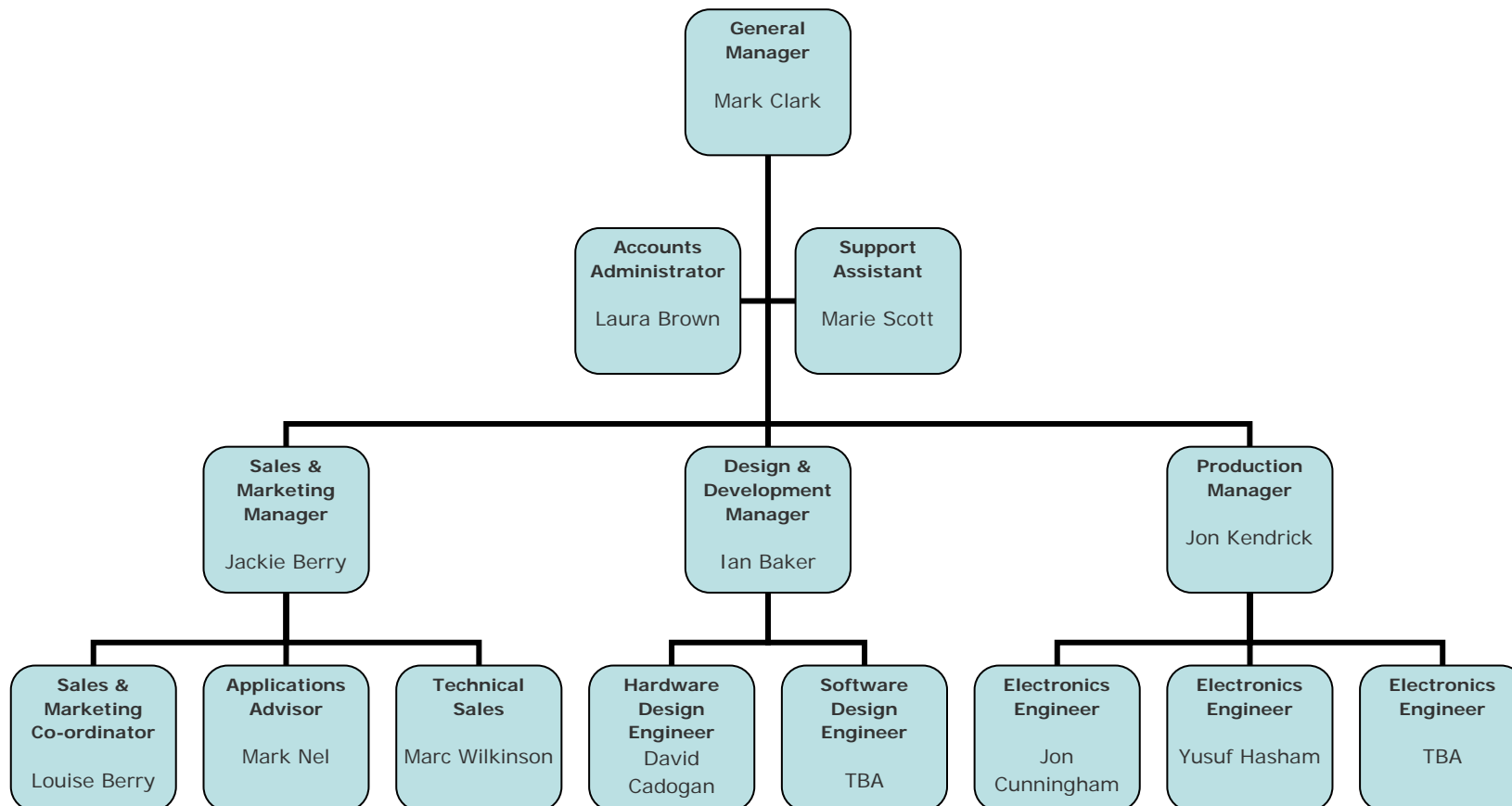
